According to your call we propose following ideas for the student teams:

1. Short-term trainings app

E-Governance Academy trains every year around 25 groups of high level government officials from various countries globally.

Trainings take place in Estonia, mainly in Tallinn, and the trainings consists lectures and study visits to the various government institutions. The task is to provide to the guests' overview about the Estonia e-governance principles and practices.

Until today we provide for the guests a lot of information in paper (agenda, training materials, feedback questionnaires, etc.). At the same time, almost all guest has smartphones or tablets and they can use wireless internet almost everywhere in the training rooms and hotels.

We'd like to provide for our guests, searching for the fully digital experience in Estonia, all training information in the digital format with the mobile app.

In cooperation with the students we'd like to develop trainings app, providing following functionality:

- Training agenda with background information
- Information about the trainers and lecturers
- Various background information
- Links to the map about the locations
- Training materials and presentations
- Feedback about the training
- Push notifications in the case of the changes
- Various languages
- Other functionalities

2. Integrated information screen

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Most of the trainings take place in our training and office premises in Tallinn.

In cooperation with the students we'd like to develop integrated information screen application. We'd like to develop solution, allowing to present in the screen following (but not limited to) data feeds:

- Weather in various locations

eGA is a joint initiative of the Government of Estonia, Open Society Institute (OSI) and United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), founded in 2002.
